Are you entitled to claim for free school meals? If you are in receipt of any of the following payments, the answer is yes.

- Income Support
- Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Child Tax Credit provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual household income, as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs that does not exceed £16,190
- Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- State Pension Credit Guarantee Element
- Employment Support Allowance Income Related
- Woking Tax Credit 'run on' the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit Universal Credit
- Universal Credit

Are you entitled but decided not to apply? Maybe because your child does not want school meals? Did you know that Welsh Government gives an extra grant for every child that is entitled to and claims free school meals. It can provide valuable extra funding to support teaching and learning in our school, at a time when budgets are being significantly reduced.

If you are entitled and have not claimed free school meals, please consider doing so. Forms are available from Miss Wilson in the school office.
