



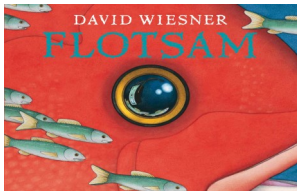
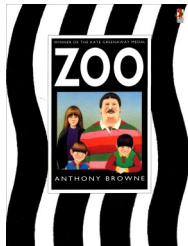

Pupils have the opportunity to voice what they would like to learn and teachers have linked these to Welsh Government requirements; therefore making their learning more purposeful and most importantly more enjoyable!

### Literacy, Language and Communication

Pupils will have the opportunity to write for a variety of purposes, including to: Write a character description, descriptive scenes, persuasive



writing, writing to inform, emailing, letter writing and poetry.

Welsh text: Writing an autobiography, persuasive poster making. Reading, performing and writing poetry.

### Mathematics

Year 3: Number and place value, mental addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, prob-



lem solving, measurement, shapes and fractions. Year 4: Number and place value, mental and written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, percentages, decimals, problem solving and measurement.

### Topic—What a load of rubbish!

Science—Understanding the Earth's resources, recycling and pollution. Investigating plastic bags. Geography— Learning how human activity affects the environment. ICT—Creating eBooks, movies and animations. Music—Composing a soundscape using percussion instruments and body percussion. DT—Investigating packaging. Art—Studying the work of Jason Scarpace. PE—Team building games, orienteering and swimming. RE—Writing Harvest prayers.
